

Traveling from Charles M. Schulz - Sonoma County Airport (STS) with Wine and Alcohol

You can check up to one case (12 bottles) of wine for free at STS! Customers traveling with properly packaged wine are permitted to check up to one box for no additional fees when traveling on Alaska Airlines / Horizon Air from Santa Rosa.



When purchasing wine, ask wineries and retailers for the appropriate packing materials.

Wine in Checked Bags Wine Skins, cushioned, leak-proof packaging for single bottles of wine in checked baggage, are available for purchase in STS terminal vending machines, online, and in many local shops and wineries. *Checked bag fees apply for alcohol packed in luggage.*

- There is no restriction on the amount of alcohol passengers may pack inside checked luggage, provided it contains fewer than 24% alcohol by volume (e.g. beer and wine). Alcohol greater than 24% up to and including 70% (140 proof) is allowed with the following restrictions:
 - Up to five liters of alcohol per package
 - Up to five liters of alcohol per person
 - Must be in retail packaging
 - Baggage fees apply (only separate wine cases are checked for free)
- Alcohol over 70% (140 proof) is prohibited.
- Alcohol restrictions, such as prohibiting the possession of alcohol, vary from city to city in the state of Alaska. It is recommended that customers educate themselves of the laws and regulations of each city in their travel itinerary. See the Alaska Alcoholic Beverage Control Board website for more information.
- For international travel, please check each country's customs requirement for import and export.
